We have two monthly meetings. One is held at the Southwick Community Centre. This is usually lecture based and frequently has external speakers covering a wide range of astronomical subjects to suit all interests. The other meeting covers practical astronomy and is held at the Clayton Hall and Recreation Ground in Hassocks where dark skies can be found.

Both beginners and experienced individuals are welcome and whether you are interested in visual astronomy, astrophotography or just enjoy learning more about astronomy in general, we are sure that you will find something to interest you.

Lecture meetings take place at the Southwick Community Centre, Southwick. BN42 4TE. These take place on the first Monday of the month from September to June inclusive and start at 07:30pm.

In addition to a broad range of professional speakers that give informative and interesting talks for every level of amateur astronomer, we also have members who give lectures and hold discussion groups on a wide range of topics from the basics to current views on astrophysics and cosmology.

After 2 visits we ask that you join our club. Our annual subscription is normally £20, but this has been reduced to £10 for the 2023/24 season. Fees "on the door" are £5 for each of the Lecture and Practical Astronomy meetings, but of course feel free to decide which you chose to attend. The Society year runs from September to June inclusive and there is no annual subscription fee for students or under 18's.
